There are many ways to vote in this election:

1. Vote Online or by Phone from 8am, Tuesday, October 6th to 7pm, Wednesday, October 14th. Go to www.halifax.ca/city-hall/election for further information. You will need your voter letter.
2. Vote in person. Paper ballots are available at two advance polls, October 10th and October 13th, or on Election Day, October 17th, 8am to 7pm. Please bring your identification.

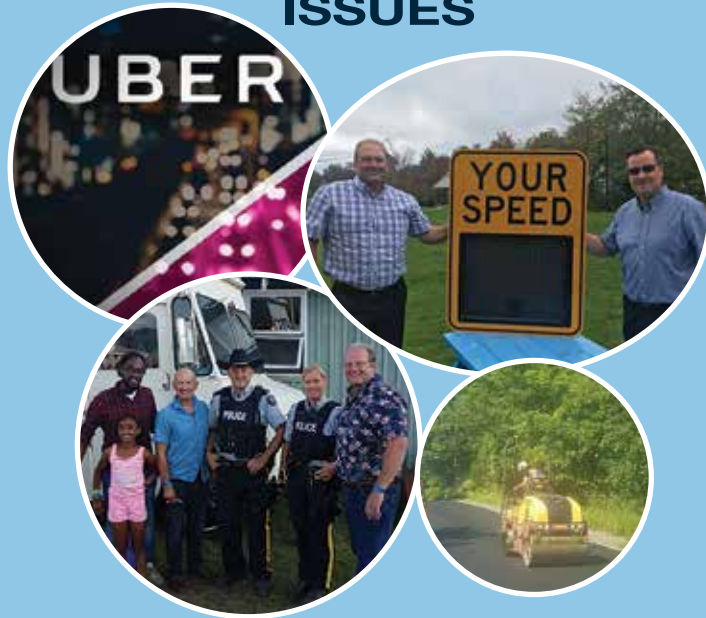
